has long been a leading New Orleans shopping area, and in the first half of the 19th century Chartres and Royal streets composed the city's main business district. Travelers' accounts of the time praised stores here which sold luxury items similar to what could be found in Paris or London. While Chartres Street catered to the fashion trade, Royal was the street of furniture makers and second-hand dealers, a fitting start to its modern reputation for antique stores. Decatur Street with the adjacent French Market sold household goods from groceries to hardware. Eventually large department and clothing stores lined nearby Canal Street, later supplanted by shopping malls. In spite of several centuries of retail change the French Quarter with its charming and intimate selling spaces continues to attract specialized, quality retailers who happily satisfy shoppers' desires in the 21st century.

THE FRENCH MARKET DISTRICT encompasses six blocks on the riverside of the Lower French Quarter. The district includes over 20 unique retail shops, performance venues, restaurants, cafes, a flea market and a farmers' market. In addition to the recreational shopping

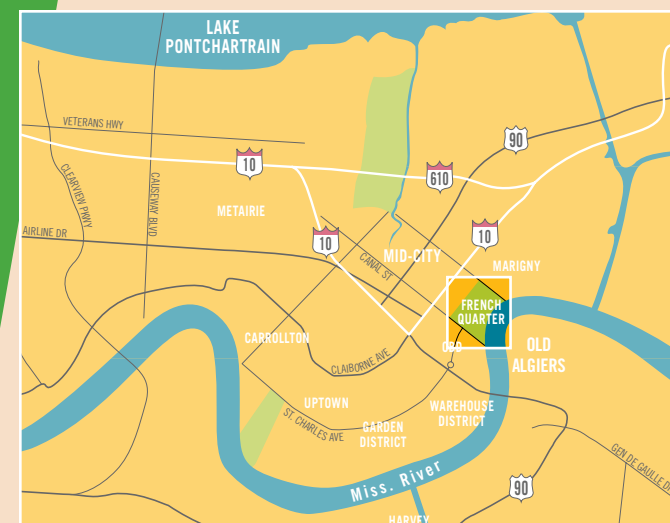
opportunities and ongoing free special events, the District boasts historical monuments such as Washington Artillery Park (across from Jackson Square) and New Place de France (home of the Joan of Arc statue), public art, scenic walkways, and convenient riverside parking. The RTA's red streetcars can also be taken to reach various sections of the District. The New Orleans Jazz National Historic Park, located in Dutch Alley, offers free educational and musical presentations Tuesday-Saturday.

The French Market, "America's Oldest Public Market", has existed on the same site since 1791. What began as a Native American trading post has become a cultural and entertainment destination that hosts annual festivals and events like The Creole Tomato Festival, French Market Christmas Tree Lighting, and Boo Carré Halloween and Harvest Festival. The recently renovated farmers' market is home to a diversity of food vendors serving prepared foods as well as fresh produce stands.

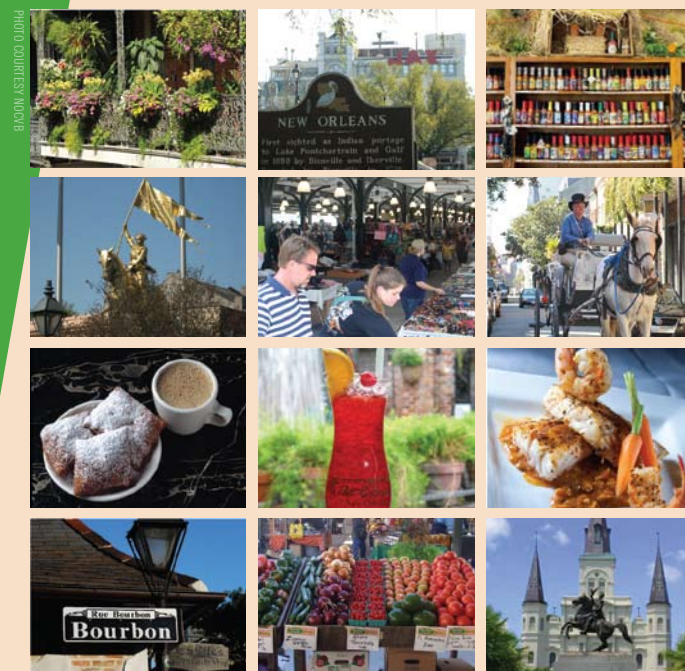
